Making an Impact: Honoring Sharol Herr

“It certainly was not a one-woman job.” Those who know Sharol Herr understand her wanting to share the spotlight the evening the Club bestowed on her its second “Lannette K. Davis Impact Award.” With a standing ovation, and a few tears, Clubwomen honored Herr for the significant impact, service and leadership she has provided over the past 10 years.

Among her many accomplishments:

- Stabilized and developed Club membership when only a handful remained.
- Strengthened the Club’s financial base enabling crucial preservation and restoration projects in the historic home.
- Created a 21st century vision and mission for the Club.
- Established a network of professionals and community leaders to support Club initiatives to share the impact of women in our community and beyond.

“What an honor to have served the Club,” she said. “And I’m not done yet.” Sharol will continue as co-chair of the History, Museum & Preservation Committee and assist Club Archivist Kelly Cunningham interpreting thousands of documents of Club history.

Board establishes 5-year goals

At its January strategic planning meeting, the Board of Directors identified working goals for the next five years. These include:

- Develop plan to increase the Club’s endowment fund at Marion Community Foundation
- Enhance Ida Barlow Award funding
- Add signage to front lawn, along True Avenue entrance, and in front of the Women’s History Resource Center
- Enhance Auditorium storage
- Restore interior/exterior windows & doors in the historic home
- Pave the path from AgCredit building; add lighting, signage
- Investigate enhancing current parking lot spaces

Following the Club mission to “empower women and enrich the community,” the Board also recommended: 1) supporting the Ida Barlow winner annually, 2) adding a member service element to each quarterly gathering, and 3) establishing a partnership for a woman-centered project.

The Board will review its goals on a regular basis, make adjustments and celebrate accomplishments.

Ida Barlow Winner has ‘a Heart’ for our Community

Angela Johnson, executive director-Grace Clinics of Ohio, is the 2025 recipient of the Club’s 2025 Ida Barlow Brilliance Award for her “Rapid EKG Screening Initiative.”

The \$1,000 award will be used to provide reliable in-house EKG testing at the Clinic, located at 140 Court St., Marion, “allowing us to identify potential heart-health issues,” explained Johnson. “The new unit will also provide immediate evaluation, and timely, reliable results—a critical component of overall health care.” Grace Clinic-Marion partners with Leapin’ Ministries and other non-profits to provide basic necessities to families in need.
